**APPLICATION APPROVED SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:**

(1) That this application shall be presented by the withdrawer or the vessel's master to the district director within 24 hours (excluding Saturday, Sunday, and holidays) after EACH SUBSEQUENT ARRIVAL of the vessel at a customs port or station from a fishing voyage, and that an accounting shall be made at the time of such presentation of the disposition of the articles withdrawn until the district director is satisfied that all of them have been consumed on board or landed under customs supervision, thereupon the district director will take up this form for final disposition;

(2) That any such withdrawn article remaining on board while the vessel is in port shall be safeguarded in the manner and to such extent as the district director for the port or place of arrival shall deem necessary; and

(3) That failure to comply with the above conditions shall subject the total quantity of withdrawn articles to the assessment and collection of any applicable duty or tax.
